**NOTICE OF PUBLIC NIGHT HEARING**

Petition of South Carolina Electric & Gas Company for Updates and Revisions to the Capital Cost Schedule and Schedules Related to the Construction of a Nuclear Base Load Generation Facility at Jenkinsville, South Carolina

On March 12, 2015, South Carolina Electric & Gas Company filed a Petition with the Public Service Commission, pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 58-33-270(E), seeking an order approving an updated construction schedule and capital cost schedule for the two 1,117 net megawatt nuclear facilities ("Units"). The updated construction schedule reflects new substantial completion dates for Units 2 and 3 of June 19, 2019, and June 16, 2020, respectively. It also incorporates in the construction cost schedules approximately \$698 million in additional capital costs that have been identified since the issuance of Order No. 2012-884. The Petition indicates that these additional costs are due to a number of factors including the delay in the substantial completion dates of the Units and the additional labor and other costs required to construct the Units and to prepare for their operation. The elements of cost are set forth in more detail in the Petition.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a **Public Night Hearing**, pursuant to 10 S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 103-817, on the above matter has been scheduled to begin on **Tuesday, July 21, 2015, at 6:00 p.m.**, before the Public Service Commission at 101 Executive Center Drive, Saluda Building, Columbia, South Carolina 29210.

Persons who wish to testify before the Public Service Commission regarding the application may do so at this hearing. Individuals shall be permitted a maximum of three (3) minutes for oral presentations. To testify as a public witness, you must print your name on the Sign-In Sheet available at the hearing location, and indicate whether or not you wish to testify. All testimony will be given under oath and entered into the record of the case subject to objection by the parties.

Please note that the commissioners will be present to listen to your testimony and statements regarding this Application. The Code of Judicial Conduct prohibits the commissioners from answering questions regarding this application or discussing this case with you individually.
