South Carolina Public Service Commission Schedules Public Hearing to Gather Customer Testimony in Docket No. 2025-250-E

Columbia, South Carolina—The Public Service Commission has scheduled an in-person customer public hearing for 6 p.m. on Monday, February 2nd, 2026, in <u>Docket No. 2025-250-E</u>, which pertains to a joint application filed by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, North Carolina Electric Membership Corporation, and Central Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (collectively, "the Companies"). In their application, the Companies seek a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction and operation of a new natural gas combined cycle generating plant in Anderson County, S.C.

This public hearing will be held at 6 p.m. on February 2nd at the Civic Center of Anderson (3027 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Anderson, SC 29625).
