### **Duke Energy Progress, LLC Files Application with the Public Service Commission Related to Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency Rider 17 (PSC Docket No. 2025-203-E)**

*Columbia, South Carolina*—Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP") has filed an application with the Public Service Commission of South Carolina seeking approval of Demand-Side Management and Energy Efficiency Rider 17 for 2026, decreasing residential and non-residential rates. This application and all other materials related to this matter have been filed in the Public Service Commission's [Docket No. 2025-203-E](#). The company anticipates a decrease in residential rates and of non-residential rates should their application be approved by the Public Service Commission.

In their application, DEP requests the following:

- Approval to recover its costs and revenue associated with DSM and EE programs under S.C. Code Ann. § 58-37-20.
- Approval of lower rates than the Company is currently recovering under its previous DSM/EE Rider 16 filing for both residential and non-residential customers.

In addition, DEP wants the Commission to issue an Order allowing the Company to recover the following revenue through the proposed Rider 17:

- \$13,028,849 from Residential Customers; and
- (\$2,001,672) from General Service Customers (signifying a decrease in revenue collected from General Service Customers)
